# PARENTAL CONTRACT SUMMER 2019

## **REGISTRATION & PAYMENTS**

	All registration forms and medication authorization must be received a minimum of 7 days prior to the session start date. We do operate on a first come; first served basis. Please do not hesitate and register early.
	All registrations must be accompanied with a $$50$ non-refundable deposit per week for each child registering. Balances are due by June $1^{\rm st}$ .
	If you are registered for multiple weeks and have set up a payment plan with the front desk, you must have a valid credit card on file. Your card will automatically be charged 7 days prior to each session of camp for your child unless payment is made prior to this date by cash or check.
	If payment (or credit card is declined for any reason) is not received 7 days prior your child's camp session, they will be dis-enrolled from that week of camp and may not attend. Deposit is non-refundable
	CAN I CHANGE MY CAMP SESSION AFTER I HAVE ALREADY REGISTERED? Yes, camp session dates can be changed with at least one week advanced written notice prior to the start of the camp session, and as camper space allows.
	I understand that if my child is not picked up by 12:00pm for half day, 3:00pm for full day and 5:30 pm for extended day, I will be charged a late pick up fee of \$5.00 per minute. This amount is DUE at time of pick up. Failure to pay the fee shall result in denied access to future camp sessions.
REFUND	POLICIES
	All refund requests must be mailed and/or e-mailed to <a href="info@aimhighacademy.com">info@aimhighacademy.com</a> . No verbal requests will be honored.  * Refunds will only be given with a medical note
	No refunds will be made to campers who withdraw at any time after arriving at camp without a doctor's note.
	Policy for illness: 100% refund for the camp day missed when a doctor's note is provided.
ENERAL	SIGN IN AND SIGN OUT INFORMATION
	At drop off, you will be asked to indicate the best phone number to reach you for that day, and who we should expect to sign out your camper.
	If an adult is picking up your camper but is not on the approved list submitted prior to camp, a note stating: the date, unlisted adult's name, camper's name and your signature must be given to the Camp Director at morning drop off.
	Please remember that at sign out time, adults will need to show identification and sign the camper out from camp each day. We will not allow any adult other than those listed on the sign out sheet to pick up your child unless a previous arrangement has been made. If there is an emergency and an adult not on the pickup list is sent to pick up a camper, the Camp Director will call the parents to verify permission, otherwise we will not allow the camper to be released.
	All medications your child may need during the day must be turned into the front desk at the beginning of each day. Parents should pick this medication up from the front desk at the end of each day. Remember only emergency medication will be administered such as epi pens or inhalers.

#### **BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS & DISMISSAL FROM CAMP**

Aim High has a philosophy of self-discipline, respect and safety. Aim High expects respectful, safe and gentle behavior at all times. Given the nature of this expectation, children with a disclosed or undisclosed behavioral difficulty, children displaying unacceptable behavior, or those who cannot perform to these standards while attending Aim High will be dismissed early, suspended or expelled.
